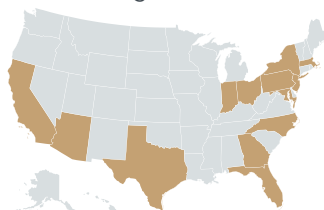

## To Apply To The George Washington University Law School

---

### THE BINDING EARLY DECISION PROGRAM: APPLICATIONS DUE FEBRUARY 1

The Binding Early Decision Program is designed for applicants who are certain GW Law is their top choice. Admitted applicants will be eligible for need-based grants; applicants who wish to be considered for merit awards should not apply through this program. Applicants must agree to attend GW Law, if admitted.

### THE BINDING PRESIDENTIAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (FULL TUITION): APPLICATIONS DUE FEBRUARY 1

All applicants admitted through the Presidential Merit Scholarship Program will be awarded a full-tuition scholarship. Applicants must agree to attend GW Law, if admitted.

### REGULAR ADMISSION PROCESS: APPLICATIONS DUE MARCH 1

Regular admission decisions will be made on a rolling basis between November and May. Students may enroll in the **full- or part-time JD program**.
